

“FORTNITE SHOWDOWN” OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

1. **General.** The “[Fortnite Showdown]” Contest (the “**Contest**”) is sponsored by Epic Games, Inc., with its address at 620 Crossroads Blvd., Cary, North Carolina 27518 (“**Epic**”). The Contest is subject to these official terms and conditions (“**Official Rules**”) and to all applicable federal, state and local laws. Each participant in the Contest will be referred to herein as an “**Entrant**”, “**you**”, or “**player**.”
2. **Eligibility.** This Contest is only open to individuals who (i) are 13 years or older; (ii) if considered a minor in their country, state, or territory of residence at the time of entry, have obtained consent of their parent or legal guardian prior to participation; (iii) are legal residents of, or physically located in, a country or territory where Epic Games operates and where this contest is not prohibited by applicable law; and (iv) are not residents of any country, region, or territory that is subject to trade restrictions, sanctions, or other legal prohibitions to this Contest (the “**Prohibited Jurisdictions**”); and (v) if selected as a winner, possess and, upon request, provide a valid government-issued identification document and any taxpayer identification number or equivalent information required by applicable law for purposes of identity verification, prize fulfillment, and tax compliance. Verification of individual Entrant’s eligibility may be required at the time you submit your entry or if selected as a Potential Winner. This Contest is only open to natural persons. Notwithstanding the above, Epic, in its sole discretion, may deem any Entrant as ineligible for a Prize(s). Employees of Epic and any of its affiliates, parent, subsidiaries, the Prize providers, contractors, advertising and sweepstakes agencies and all other service agencies involved with the Contest (collectively, the “**Contest Entities**”), together with the immediate families (spouses, parents, children, siblings, and their respective spouses) and those persons living in the same household (whether or not related) as such employees are not eligible to enter.
3. **Entry Period.** The Contest begins on March 19, 2026, at 7:00am Eastern Standard Time and ends on April 16, 2026, at 11:59pm Eastern Standard Time (the “**Entry Period**”). Epic’s computer shall be the official timekeeper for all matters related to this Contest.
4. **How to Enter.** During the Entry Period, you may enter the participating in Epic’s Battle Royale Chapter 7, Season 2, entitled Fortnite Showdown (an “**Entry**”).
5. **Winner Selection.** After the Entry Period has ended, the winners (each, a “**Potential Winner**” and, collectively, the “**Potential Winners**”) will be selected as the top five (5), top twenty (20), top one-hundred (100), and/or top five hundred (500) players based on the Contest leaderboards as of the conclusion of the Entry Period. By entering the Contest, Entrants fully and unconditionally agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of Epic, which will be final and binding in all matters relating to the Contest.
6. **Prize.** Prizes are awarded in the following manner: (a) Top five (5) players: each player to reach the top 5 player threshold on the Global Leaderboard a weekly basis, to be chosen at a time and date determined by Epic, will receive a GeForce RTX 5080 Founders Edition GPU (“**GPU Prize**”), which has a cash value of approximately Nine Hundred and Ninety-Nine U.S. Dollars (\$999). (b) Top twenty (20) players: each player to reach the top 20 player threshold on the Global Leaderboard at the conclusion of the Entry Period will receive a PlayStation5 (“**PS5 Prize**”), which has a cash value of approximately Five Hundred U.S. Dollars (\$500). (c) Top one-hundred (100) players: each player to reach the top 100 on the Team Foundation Leaderboard, Team Ice King Leaderboard, and Team Creators Leaderboard at the conclusion of the Entry Period will receive a Team Foundation or Team Ice King Apparel (“**Apparel Prize**”), which has a cash value of Forty U.S. Dollars (\$40). (d) Top five hundred (500) players: each player to reach the top 250 on the Team Foundation Leaderboard, Team Ice King Leaderboard, and Team Creators Leaderboard at the conclusion of the Entry Period will receive a Fortnite Custom Keychain (“**Key Chain Prize**”), which has a cash value of thirteen U.S. Dollars (\$13). The GPU Prize, PS5 Prize, Apparel Prize, and Key Chain Prize are collectively referred to as “**Prize**” or “**Prizes**.” Any and all taxes of any of the Prizes is the sole responsibility of the winner. Prizes are non-transferable and no substitution or cash equivalent is allowed except in Epic’s sole discretion. Epic reserves the right to substitute the Prize of the same approximate retail value. Additional terms and conditions may apply.
7. **Anti-stacking & Fairplay Rules for Prizes.** To maintain competitive integrity and prize award fairness, the following rules apply to Prizes and Prize eligibility for players: An Entrant may only receive a maximum of one (1) GPU prize. If at any point during the Entry Period an Entrant has already won a GPU, and at the end of a subsequent week the Entrant reaches a top five (5) position, this player is ineligible for an additional GPU Prize. The GPU Prize will be awarded to the next highest eligible player on that leaderboard. If an Entrant wins a GPU Prize during the Entry Period, the Entrant’s eligibility for the other Prizes (e.g., PS5, apparel, and keychain) is unaffected.
8. **Claiming the Prize.** Potential Winner will be notified of their selection in an initial notification e-mail to the email on the Winner’s official Fortnite account. Potential Winner must follow the Prize claim instructions provided as part of the initial notification and any subsequent claim instructions, otherwise the Prize will be forfeited in its entirety. Winning is subject to verification of eligibility, including verification of age, and compliance with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules. Failure to respond to the initial

notification within twenty (20) days will result in disqualification. To claim the Prize, Potential Winner may be required to sign and return within twenty (20) days, where legal, winner's documents, which may include an eligibility declaration, general liability and publicity release, and other necessary documents. If Potential Winner cannot be contacted in the first two (2) attempts, fails to sign and return requested documents within the required time period, or if any prize notification is returned as undeliverable, or if Potential Winner rejects its Prize, or in the event of noncompliance with these Official Rules and requirements, such Prize will be forfeited, and Epic may award the Prize to the Entrant that received the next highest score. Upon any Prize forfeiture, Epic will give no compensation. If Potential Winner is a minor in their country, region, or territory, Potential Winner's parent or guardian shall be required to submit the Winner's Documents and claim the Prize on the Potential Winner's behalf. Upon Potential Winner's completion of the Winner's Documents, Epic will endeavor to deliver the Prize within ninety (90) days of the acceptance of the Winner's Documents. Epic will deliver, or cause to be delivered, the Prize to winner's address as provided to Epic. Contest Entities are not responsible for any undelivered emails, messages or any other communications, including but not limited to those that are not received because of winner's privacy or spam filter settings that may divert any email, message or other Contest related email to a spam or junk folder. Entrants agree to permit any of the Contest Entities to contact them concerning the Contest. Winner agrees to permit Epic to publicize, unless not permitted by applicable law, winner's names.

9. **Taxes.** Winner is solely responsible for any and all applicable taxes, fees and other government assessments associated with receipt and use of a Prize or participation in this Contest. Epic reserves the right to withhold or deduct any amounts required under applicable law and to request and obtain any documentation, including tax identification numbers or forms, necessary to comply with applicable tax reporting or withholding obligations in the winner's jurisdiction of residence. Winners may be issued tax reporting forms as required by law.
10. **Release.** By entering, Entrant agrees to accept and abide by these Official Rules and agrees that any dispute with regard to the conduct of this Contest, rule interpretation, or award of the Prize shall be submitted to Epic, whose decision shall be binding and final. By participating, Entrant agrees to release and hold harmless Epic, the Prize provider, distributors, and promotional and other vendor agencies, their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, service agencies, independent contractors, and the officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives of any of the above organizations from any injury, loss, or damage to person, including death, or property due in-whole or in-part, directly or indirectly, to the acceptance or use/misuse of the Prize, participation in any Contest-related activity, or participation in the Contest. Entrant further acknowledges that they may be waiving rights with respect to claims that are at this time unknown or unsuspected, and, to the extent relevant to them, in accordance with such waiver, Entrant acknowledges that they have read and understand, and hereby expressly waive, the benefits of Section 1542 of the civil code of California, and any similar law of any state or territory, which provides as follows: "a general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him or her must have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor."

Epic is not responsible for any typographical or other error in the printing of this offer, administration of the Contest, or in the announcement of the Prize, including erroneous appearance of qualification for the Prize, and under no circumstances will more than the stated number of Prizes be awarded. Epic reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to modify, cancel, or suspend this Contest, or to amend the Official Rules at any time, without prior individual notice, should any factor interfere with the administration, security, or proper play of this Contest as contemplated by these Official Rules. If Epic in its discretion elects to so abbreviate the Contest, Epic reserves the right, but not the obligation, to award the prize from among all eligible entries received to date.

Epic assumes no responsibility for computer system, hardware, software, or program malfunctions or other errors, failures, delayed computer transactions, or network connections, whether human, technical, or otherwise in nature. Epic reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend this Contest should virus, bugs, or other causes beyond its control corrupt the administration, security, or proper play of this Contest. Epic is not responsible for any injury or damage to any person's computer or related equipment resulting from or relating to participation in this Contest or downloading/uploading any material related to this Contest. Entries will be deemed made by the authorized account holder of the e-mail address submitted at the time of Entry. In the event of a dispute, the Potential Winner may be required to provide proof that he or she is the authorized holder of the identified e-mail account.

11. **Prohibited Jurisdictions.** The Contest is not open to individuals who are restricted or prohibited by applicable law or in any country where participation is prohibited by U.S. law, including Cuba, Iran, Iraq, North Korea, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, and the regions of Crimea, Donetsk, and Luhansk. Additionally, individuals residing in Brazil, Afghanistan, Yemen, and Libya are prohibited from participating in the Contest.
12. **Language.** To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the controlling language for this Agreement is English. It is the express wish of the parties that this Agreement and all related documents have been drawn up in English. Any translation has been provided for your convenience.

13. **Disputes/Limitation of Liability/Choice of Law**. EXCEPT WHERE PROHIBITED, EACH ENTRANT AGREES THAT: (1) ANY AND ALL DISPUTES, CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED WITH THIS CONTEST OR ANY PRIZE AWARDED SHALL BE RESOLVED INDIVIDUALLY, WITHOUT RESORT TO ANY FORM OF CLASS ACTION, AND EXCLUSIVELY BY STATE OR FEDERAL COURTS SITUATED IN NORTH CAROLINA, (2) NORTH CAROLINA LAW, WITHOUT REFERENCE TO CHOICE OF LAW RULES, GOVERNS THE CONTEST AND ALL ASPECTS RELATED THERETO, (3) ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, JUDGMENTS AND AWARDS SHALL BE LIMITED TO ACTUAL OUT-OF-POCKET COSTS INCURRED, BUT IN NO EVENT ATTORNEYS' FEES, (4) NO PUNITIVE, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR OTHER DAMAGES, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, LOST PROFITS, MAY BE AWARDED (COLLECTIVELY, "**SPECIAL DAMAGES**"), AND (5) ENTRANT HEREBY WAIVES ALL RIGHTS TO CLAIM SPECIAL DAMAGES AND ALL RIGHTS TO SUCH DAMAGES MULTIPLIED OR INCREASED.
